## **TODAY'S MESSAGE**

Dear St. Cyprian Family,

In our Gospel this Sunday, Jesus speaks of a grain of wheat that must fall to the earth and die to bear much fruit. It's a powerful image as we approach the culmination of Lent. Just as the grain of wheat seems to surrender its life, it actually transforms and brings forth a bountiful harvest.

We, too, are called to this journey of surrender and transformation. During Lent, we examine the areas of our lives that need to "die." These might be old habits, negative thought patterns, or attachments that hold us back from living in the fullness of Christ's love.

The challenge is to trust that this surrender, like the single grain of wheat, is not an end but a beginning. As we let go of what no longer serves us, we create space within our hearts for new life. This new life is the fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, and all the beautiful qualities that reflect the Risen Christ.

Let us embrace this final week of Lent with courage and hope. Let us not shy away from the necessary "dying" so that we may experience the abundant life that Jesus promises. May we all blossom in the light of Easter!


## RICE BOWL
