TODAY'S MESSAGE

Dear St, Cyprian Family,

This third week of Lent, the image of Jesus cleansing the temple resonates deeply. His actions challenge us to reflect on the need for **inner purification**, reminding us that the true temple lies within. It's not just about external spaces; it's about cleansing the very core of our being.

Points for Reflection:

Where do we encounter "money changers" in our own lives? Are there areas of greed, pride, or judgment that cloud our hearts and hinder our connection with God?

Do we allow fear, anger, or negativity to take root? Are there any unresolved conflicts or unforgiveness weighing us down

Do we prioritize outward appearances over genuine compassion and service? Are we truly vessels of God's love in the world?

Prayerful Actions:

Dedicate time to quiet reflection and prayer. Ask God to reveal any areas needing purification, listening with an open heart.


Seek the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Confess your sins and receive God's forgiveness, allowing His cleansing grace to wash over you.

Practice acts of compassion and service. Extend kindness to those in need, reflecting God's love outward and purifying your own intentions.

Engage in spiritual practices like fasting, almsgiving or reading Scripture. Nourish your soul and deepen your relationship with God.

Remember, this cleansing is not a one-time act but a continuous journey. Throughout Lent, let us embrace Jesus' cleansing spirit, allowing Him to purify our hearts and transform us into vessels of His love.
