TODAY'S MESSAGE

Dear St. Cyprian Family,

Have you ever felt like your world was turned upside down by something unbelievable? That's what happened to Jesus' first disciples. They had witnessed His horrific crucifixion, watched Him die a criminal's death. But then, impossibly, He appeared to them alive! At first they were unsettled by this, thinking He was a ghost. But Jesus showed them the wounds in His hands and feet - it really was Him, miraculously raised from the dead. Just as the disciples were commissioned as witnesses to these events, so are we today. Christ is risen and that changes everything!

We all face suffering, setbacks, and even times when our hopes seem utterly dead. But the resurrection of Jesus is the paradigm-shattering event that turned the disciples' despair into confidence that God's love will ultimately prevail over every evil, every loss, every cross we bear. Like those first stunned witnesses, we too are called to proclaim this gospel of hope to our hurting world.

My brothers and sisters, let us not hold this message inside. Let us share it courageously! Reach out with compassion to the brokenhearted, be a messenger of resurrection joy to the depressed and despairing. As we have been forgiven, forgive others lavishly. For we now know that no darkness, no tomb is too deep for the radiance of our Risen Lord and Savior.

Throughout the Diocese of San José, priests serve as loving shepherds to their flocks in our parishes and ministries. There are 45 retired priests in the Diocese and 92 others currently serving in our parishes and in other diocesan assignments. In addition, the Diocese has 38 priests reaching retirement age (70 years old) in the next 12 years and 8 in just the next three years.
