## TODAY'S MESSAGE

Dear St. Cyprian Family,

Perhaps as kids, many of us had an experience like this: We wandered away from our parents and suddenly felt lost and alone. Fear crept in as we realized we'd strayed too far in that unfamiliar place. But then our parent or guardian would find us, relieved and reassuring - they had come to lead us back safely. That's the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd who leaves the ninety nine to find the one stray, vulnerable little lamb and gently carry it home on his shoulders, rejoicing.

Too often in life, we stray like that little lamb into dangers, temptations, or hurtful situations leaving us feeling alone, despairing that no one understands or cares about us. But Jesus does!
