TODAY'S MESSAGE

Dear St. Cyprian Family,

Pruning a plant or tree is a paradoxical process where cutting portions away doesn't damage the plant's fruitfulness but actually enhances it by redirecting nutrients to the remaining branches. Jesus uses this illustration of the vine and branches to describe our spiritual union with him. He is the vine, the source of our life and energy. And we are the branches utterly dependent on him for our spiritual vitality and fruitfulness.

Sometimes God needs to perform "pruning" in our lives as well. Habits, attitudes, relationships or pursuits that are unhealthy or depleting our spiritual vigor may need to be cut away, as painful as that feels in the moment. These seasons allow Christ to re-direct his life-giving sap into the core of our being so we can flourish anew in fellowship with him.

Conversely, when we neglect our connection to the vine, we become like dead, withered branches that must be cleared away. How crucial it is to "remain" or "abide" in Christ daily through prayer, scripture, corporate worship, the sacraments! Staying firmly grafted into him is the only way we'll bear the beautiful fruits of Christlike love, joy, peace and more. Let us examine our connection to the Vine this week and prune away any barriers keeping us from vital and deeper communion with Jesus, our Lord.

I would also like to take this opportunity to share some news with you. I have received a new assignment from our Bishop. Effective July 1, I will be the pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Parish in San Jose. While this news brings mixed emotions, I want to express my deepest and most sincere gratitude for the love and support you have shown me throughout my time with you. Being your pastor has been such a special part of my life. I've learned so much from you, and your kindness has always meant the world to me.

I'll miss you all very much, but I know this wonderful church community will continue to be a place of faith and friendship.

I'm also happy to tell you that Fr. Robain Lamba will be your new pastor. He's currently the parochial vicar at St. Francis of Assisi Parish,
