TODAY'S MESSAGE

Dear St. Cyprian Family,

As we continue the joyous season of Easter, our hearts brim with the hope of Christ's resurrection. On this Second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate a special feast – Divine Mercy Sunday – a day dedicated entirely to experiencing the boundless compassion of our Lord.

We draw inspiration from the Gospel of John (20:19-31), where we witness the risen Christ appearing to his disciples, filled with fear and doubt behind locked doors. Jesus enters, uttering the powerful words, "Peace be with you." He doesn't scold them for their lack of faith; instead, he offers peace, a peace rooted in his immense mercy.

Just as Jesus offered forgiveness and peace to his disciples, he extends the same invitation to us today. We are all susceptible to doubt, fear, and feelings of isolation. But Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us that God's love knows no bounds. He yearns for us to approach him, to confess our shortcomings, and to receive his overwhelming mercy.

In the Gospel passage, Jesus breathes on the disciples, imparting the Holy Spirit, the source of God's grace and mercy. This act signifies the power of the Sacraments, particularly Reconciliation and Holy Communion, which are channels through which we receive God's forgiveness and strengthen our faith.

This Divine Mercy Sunday, let us:

- **Reflect on God's boundless mercy:** Spend time in prayer or meditation, acknowledging God's presence in your life and his unwavering love.
- **Embrace the Sacrament of Reconciliation:** Seek forgiveness and experience the liberating power of God's mercy.
- **Receive Holy Communion:** Draw closer to Christ and allow his love to fill your heart.
- **Share God's mercy with others:** Perform acts of kindness and forgiveness, reflecting the love you receive from God.

May this Divine Mercy Sunday be a day of profound renewal and a reminder that God's love and forgiveness are always available to us.
